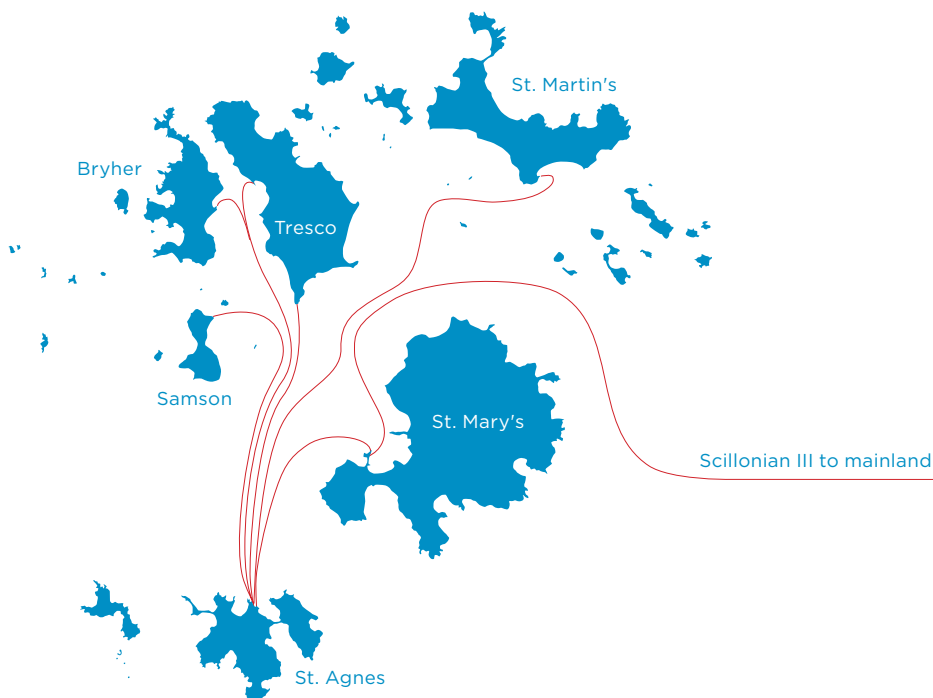


Boats from St. Agnes



St. Agnes Boating runs scheduled services daily from St. Agnes to St. Mary's and to the other islands on Scilly. They meet the Scillonian daily to take you from St. Mary's to St. Agnes and also connect sailings with your Skybus flight. Their boats are the purpose built catamaran, 'Spirit of St. Agnes' and 'Enterprise'.

SCHEDULED FARES

Scheduled fares are £5.20 single per person and half price for under sixteens.

SKYBUS TRANSFERS AND ONE WAY CHARTERS

St. Agnes Boating transfers all arriving Skybus passengers to St. Agnes. Transfers can be booked by calling 01720 422704, following the "How to find us" link on their website or by emailing john@stagnesboating.co.uk. Skybus Passengers arriving after 16.00 will miss the scheduled boat and will need to book a transfer using their sea-taxi services.

The transfer will cost up to a total of £45 per person. It will be cheaper if you share your boat with other travelers. For example, two people would pay £22.50 each. St. Agnes Boating will be waiting at the quay for you if your flight is delayed as long as you have advised them of your flight details in advance.

This price includes all people traveling: £45 one way from 07.45 to 19.00 between St. Agnes and St. Mary's.

- £50 one way from 7.45 to 19.00 to any inhabited island.

£57 one way 07.00 to 07.45 and 19.00 to 21.30.

Parties of nine or more people are charged at £5.20 per person but £10 per person between 21.00 and 7.45.

TRIPS TO ST. MARY'S

St. Agnes Boating sails for St. Mary's Monday to Saturday (Sundays in July and August) departing at 10.15 and 15.15, returning from St. Mary's at 12.30 and 16.30 (15.45 on Friday, Saturday and Sunday).

TRIPS TO TRESKO, BRYHER, ST. MARTIN'S AND SAMSON

Scheduled trips to Tresco are twice a week and Bryher and St. Martin's once a week. From late May they offer a weekly trip to explore the uninhabited island of Samson.

Weekly timetables are published every Friday and are posted to their website and can be viewed on the App. These trips change due to tidal conditions so its best to check for exact departure times.

WILDLIFE TRIPS

Every Wednesday they provide a wildlife safari trip in partnership with Isles of Scilly Wildlife Trust to see the islands' seabirds, seals and puffins.

WEEKLY PASS

Enjoy 8 days boating for the price of 4 days. The pass allows for unlimited travel on all scheduled trips with St. Agnes Boating with the exception of the Wildlife Safaris and Sea-Taxi services. The pass costs £44 per adult, £22 per child and £110 per family. The saving for a family is up to £158 for a family and £54 for an individual. The pass is non-transferable and non-refundable.

DAY TRIP FAMILY SAVER FARE

Travel to any island on a day trip for £27.

DOGS

Dogs are free to travel with St. Agnes Boating but they request that animals are kept on a lead at all times.

LUGGAGE

Please ensure that each item is labeled with your name, holiday accommodation address and if possible a mobile phone number. All luggage is moved by hand and on return to St. Mary's passengers are requested to assist in moving luggage up the quay steps. Please avoid bringing large bulky items including heavy trunks. St. Agnes Boating reserves the right to charge for excess luggage at £2.50 per item.

St. Agnes Boating prefers not to carry unaccompanied luggage. If you do require luggage to be transported unaccompanied a charge of £3 per item will apply. Items must be booked 24 hours before travel by calling 01720 422704. Unaccompanied luggage that is not pre-booked will be subject to a £5.00 administration and transfer fee per item.

FREIGHT CHARGES

Bicycles are classed as freight and are not included in our standard fares. The charge is £10 to transfer bicycles.

St. Agnes Boating do not transport Windsurfers, Small outboards up to 10hp, inflatable boats, Canoes and Sea Kayaks. Passengers should contact Isles of Scilly Travel to transfer these items.
