

Scillonian III Safety Video Transcript

“Ladies and gentlemen, welcome onboard Scillonian III.

Before we depart, please give us your attention for a minute for a short, safety announcement.

You’ll find information about our emergency and safety procedures on notice boards around the ship. It’s important you read them early in the voyage because they tell you how to put on a lifejacket and where to find the emergency muster stations.

An emergency is very unlikely during the crossing; but if we do need you to assemble at your nearest muster station, you’ll hear at least 7 short blasts on the ship’s whistle or alarm bells, followed by 1 long one, like this.

If you hear the signal, a crewmember will meet you at the muster station to give you a lifejacket.
