Just 28 miles off the Cornish coast, the Isles of Scilly feel like a secret world — close enough to glimpse on a clear day, yet far enough to feel deliciously remote. In 2026, these islands call to the curious, the dreamers, and those longing to reconnect with nature, with loved ones, and with themselves.

Across five inhabited islands and countless unspoiled islets, the Isles of Scilly offer an adventure shaped by simplicity. Mornings might begin with the scent of sea salt and wildflowers carried on the breeze. Days unfold at the pace of the tide: cycling along quiet lanes, wandering barefoot across shell-white beaches, or gliding by kayak between islands where seals laze on sunlit rocks. The water, impossibly clear and blue, shimmers like something borrowed from the Caribbean — yet this is unmistakably British, with granite cliffs, gig boats, and the distant call of seagulls.

Connection thrives here. You'll find it in the warmth of a local welcome, in the easy rhythm of conversation over a pint by the harbour, and in the stillness of a sunset that seems to pause the world. Each island has its own character. The relative bustle

of St Mary's, Tresco's subtropical gardens, St Agnes's wild edges, Bryher's quiet coves or the world-class beaches of St Martin's — yet together they tell one story: of community, care, and a deep respect for the sea that binds them.

The Isles of Scilly aren't about ticking off sights or chasing schedules. They're about slowing down, tuning in, and rediscovering what matters most. Whether you arrive by Scillonian III or Skybus, there's a moment when the mainland fades and something shifts and the air feels softer, lighter, freer.

So, in 2026, cross that short stretch of sea and step into another world. The Isles of Scilly await: a place of pure island magic, where adventure and tranquillity meet, and where every visit feels like coming home.

Travel by Scillonian III...

For almost five decades, Scillonian III has been more than just a ferry, it's been part of the islands' heart and heritage.

Step aboard Scillonian III for her final year of service in 2026, as she sails to the enchanting Isles of Scilly for one last unforgettable season.

This is your last chance to experience the charm of the iconic ferry that has captured hearts since 1977.

Explore breathtaking coastlines, enjoy exceptional service and create timeless memories before Scillonian IV arrives in 2027.

Don't miss this opportunity to be part of maritime history – celebrate Scillonian III's farewell season and discover why she remains a beloved favourite.

The crossing takes two hours and 45 minutes from Penzance, up to seven days a week from spring until late autumn.

There are comfy, reclining seats inside and you can enjoy hot and cold drinks and a range of snacks from the on-board cafe, Western Rocks Coffee Company. Log onto our free on-board WiFi and browse our digital island guide, S-Magazine.

Dogs are welcome on board too with designated areas for your four-legged friend.

Travelling to the ferry departure point is an easy process too. Penzance Quay is just a short walk from the town's train station, with its direct rail services to London Paddington. If you're driving, there is ample car parking nearby.





Travel by Skybus...

You could travel on our very own airline, Skybus, which has been serving the islands for more than 40 years. Flying gives you unmatched views of the Cornish coastline and islands below.

The flight takes just 20 minutes from Land's End Airport (year-round), 30 minutes from Newquay (year-round) and an hour from Exeter (May to October).

Your experience starts as soon as you step into the airport. Small and friendly with no long waits at check-in and no passport control, you only need to be there an hour before your flight. It's about as stress-free as air travel gets.

Relax before you're called to board your Skybus flight to Scilly and take the short stroll across the Tarmac to meet your pilot.

Take in the breathtaking aerial views of Cornwall and prepare

yourself for the islands coming into view for the first time. That's an experience you'll never forget.

There is a dedicated shuttle bus running between Land's End Airport and Penzance train station, enabling connections from Skybus flights to GWR rail services. Secure car parking and electric vehicle charging is available at Land's End Airport.

If you're torn between flying and sailing, you can do both with a Fly+Sail option offering the chance to book a Skybus flight to Scilly with a Scillonian return journey - an especially memorable way of enjoying a day trip to Scilly.



Something for everyone...

You don't need to go abroad to discover something new and adventurous. On Scilly, you can view your own country with fresh eyes and realise that, even close to home, people often live differently to you.

Take yourself away from what you know and throw yourself into a whole new place. The Isles of Scilly is somewhere different, somewhere new, somewhere unique. Somewhere unforgettable.

As far as activities are concerned, these small islands really pack a punch.

Do you like to immerse yourself in your destination? Then try the quintessential – possibly all-time favourite – activity of island-hopping. Just jump on board an iconic inter-island boat from St Mary's Quay and head off to the off-island communities, where you'll be welcomed with the emptiest of beaches, swathes of coastal paths, the freshest local seafood, tiny honest stalls, pubs with views to-die-for, watersports in the clearest of clear

seas and so much more.

Or do you prefer hands-on experiences? How about snorkelling with Scilly's resident seals? Or making your own island gin? Perhaps you fancy trotting across the white sands of Pelistry Bay on horseback? Or joining a wildlife spotting boat trip?

You could explore the coastline by paddleboard or kayak, try coasteering or join a wild swimming excursion. Then there's family-friendly rock pool safaris or perhaps the favourite pastime, beachcombing.

If water-based activities aren't your thing, you could explore by pedal power or golf buggy, or play golf at the UK's most southerly golf course, with 360-degree island views in every direction.

Something for everyone...

How about activities that ignite the senses?

Scilly is home to not one, but two vineyards where you can tour the vines, raise a glass and even enjoy a lobster lunch. If something stronger is more your tittle, you could make your own island gin, or tour the first and only rum distillery on the islands.

Then there's the food. Scilly takes pride in its fresh local produce – and so it should. We're talking food metres, not miles, when it comes to how far the ingredients have travelled here. Whether it's a celebration meal, or picnic on the beach, the islands have much to offer every taste.

If it's nature you're after, Scilly is a true natural playground with mile upon mile of coast path, inland trails and, of course, beaches where yours could be the only footprints in the sand. The world-famous Abbey Gardens on Tresco live up to the hype, a sanctuary for 2,000 exotic plants.

Perhaps it's a focus on personal wellbeing. There's wild yoga or guided trail running, Thai massage and art classes.

Why not engage in an island way of life? You could visit the weekly farmers' market or meet up with island residents for a guided swim. Then there's the many island makers, whose galleries and workshops are the highlight of a visit for so many.

For a special occasion, you could go all-out with a yacht charter, complete with decadent picnic, to explore the archipelago at your own pace.

All of these experiences, and many more, can be enjoyed in just a day in one of the most beautiful and unspoilt parts of the world.




